Next Sunday we are planning to celebrate the Lord's Supper during our Worship Service. As we remember our Savior's Death and celebrate His Resurrection, we recall that Christ came to give His life as payment for the sins of His people. We are invited to partake in the feast of the Bread and the Wine, not because we are perfect or without sin, in fact just the opposite. Because we are sinful in our daily lives, the grace of God is abundant for us. Our sins are paid for, and we are called to live in a way that reflects the mercy we have been shown. Participation in the Lord's Supper is a renewal of our commitment to life as a Christian.

We must understand that the bread and cup are a sign and a seal of the true reality in the body and blood of Christ. But then, we must realize that living as a Christian has relationship obligations. We must ask God to show us sins that we harbor in our hearts toward others or toward Him. And then confess these sins to God *and* to those we have hurt by our attitudes and actions, so that we may live as a unified body of Christ on earth

The challenge of the Lenten Season is to remember the Grace and Mercy of our Savior, which He has freely given to us, prepare your hearts and minds this week, as a believer in the finished work of Christ, to receive the blessing of this Grace as we gather around His table next week.
