When we realize how much we have received from Christ, our celebration of the Lord’s Supper takes on new meaning. In fact, when we realize the work of Christ in paying for our sins and giving us His righteousness, all of our Worship takes on new meaning. We worship God in all parts of our lives as we live, accomplishing our work to His honor and glory. We also come together as a body to praise and honor the One who has given to us the greatest gift, Salvation by Grace alone through Faith alone in Christ alone.

This week as you prepare to come and worship, as you consider the meaning of the Bread and the Cup that we will eat and drink together next Sunday, remember that in preparing we must repent and turn away from all sin in our lives, because our sins separate us from God and from each other. **Question 18:** What is sinful about man’s fallen condition?

**Answer: The sinfulness of that fallen condition is twofold. First, in what is commonly called original sin, there is the guilt of Adams’s first sin and its lack of original righteousness and the corruption of his whole nature. Second are all the specific acts of disobedience that come from original sin.**

**Question 19:** What is the misery of man’s fallen condition?

**Answer: By their fall all mankind lost fellowship with God, 1 and brought His anger and curse on themselves.2 They are therefore subject to all the miseries in this life, to death itself, and to the pains of hell for ever.**
