Question 31: What is effectual calling?

**Answer: Effectual calling is the work of God's Spirit,<sup>1</sup> whereby, convincing us of our sin and misery,<sup>2</sup> enlightening our minds in the knowledge of Christ,<sup>3</sup> and renewing our wills,<sup>4</sup> he persuades and enable us to embrace Jesus Christ, freely offered to us in the gospel.**
