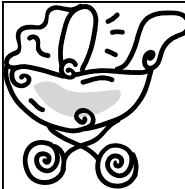

Question 45: Which is the first commandment?

**Answer: The first commandment is, Thou shalt have no other gods before me.1**

Question 46: What is required in the first commandment?

**Answer: The first commandment requires us to know and acknowledge God to be the only true God, and our God;1 and to worship and glorify him accordingly.2**

11 Chron. 28:9; Deut. 26:17; 2Matt. 4:10; Ps. 29:2

Question 47: What is forbidden in the first commandment?

**Answer: The first commandment forbids the denying,1 or not worshipping and glorifying the true God as God,2 and our God;3 and the giving of that worship and glory to any other, which is due to him alone.4**
